 - A hearing on the grants submitted has been held in Des Moines, IA on September 18th. DMC Conservation was unsuccessful in two different grant attempts.
 - The 25 Anniversary will be this coming year. A 25 Million Campaign is being conducted in an effort to have the legislative process fund REAP at 25 Million.
 - REAP Assembly will be held on October 23rd, 2013 at the Burlington Public Library.

- 1. Top shot was again a success! This year pre-registration was required. There were three categories and each had a limit of 25 entrants. Most all were filled and approximately \$800.00 was brought in for this fundraiser.
- 2. The cabin is ready with the exception of a couple of pieces of furniture. Rules and Regulations concerning the scheduling of the cabin are in progress.
- 3. IACCB Conference was held at Lake Okoboji. Director Lee and Board Member Worley attended. The conference was well attended and the presenters were well versed. Des Moines County Conservation was presented an award from Izaak Walton League of Iowa for Habitat. More will be given on the award under Information items.
- 4. Conservation Board Member Applications. As of this date there have been no applications for this position.

- b. Archaeology Survey on Baker.

As a result of the changes to the grant on the Baker project it now required that a more thorough Archaeological examination be completed.

Request for Proposals (RFP's) have been sent out. Four (4) have been returned. The amounts vary from \$5,000 to \$35,000. Chris is reviewing the proposals. He will work with the County Attorney's Office on the preparation of a contract regarding required services as it applies to the Archaeology Survey as required by DOT.

12. Informational Items/Correspondence/Board Comments:

a. Habitat Award: Director Lee presented a plaque that was presented in an Awards Ceremony at the IAACB Conference this year. Des Moines County Conservation was awarded 3rd place by the Iowa Chapter of Izaak Walton League. This award was for the habitat programs that have been put in place by Des Moines County Conservation here locally.

Chris will be getting with Natural Resource Manager, Andrew Mason, as it was due to much of his outstanding work that this award was received.

The Board congratulated Director Lee, Natural Resource Manager and all of Des Moines County Conservation Staff for their continuing contributions to conservation and habitat at the local level.
