Carter reported on the two bids received to install a concrete box culvert on 190th Street. The low bid was received from Iowa Bridge & Culvert Co. in the amount of \$145,415.35. Carter will present contracts to be signed in a future meeting.

Cary moved to approve appointments to the HIPAA Committee. Broeker seconded.
