The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2014, with Bob Beck and Jim Cary present. Tom Broeker was absent.

Meet with Department Heads: County Engineer Brian Carter reported that Mediapolis Road might be open by the end of the week or first of next week, depending on rain. County Recorder Lisa Schreiner announced that hunting season is open. ATV and snowmobile licenses are due by the end of December. The late penalty is \$5.

Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$435,113.82 were approved upon motion by Cary and second by Beck.

The following personnel actions were approved: at County Conservation, Alex Buhmeyer was hired as Operations Manager at the salary of \$41,600. Motion to approve was made by Cary and seconded by Beck. At the Correctional Center, Bobby Roark, FT Correctional Officer, was given a 36 month step increase. Shelby Standard, PT C O, received her six month anniversary increase. Richard Wissinger, part time cook, resigned effective October 13, 2014. Motion to approve all three actions was made by Cary and seconded by Beck.
