The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Courthouse in Burlington at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022, with Chairman Jim Cary and Vice-Chair Shane McCampbell present. Member Tom Broeker was present via Webex. This meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Meet with Department Heads: Deputy Auditor Sara Doty stated she remains busy. IT Director Colin Gerst stated the office is busy. Sheriff Kevin Glendening stated they held the graduation of the Youth Academy last week. He was very pleased with the turnout of the program. The jail population is at 70. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener stated he has several projects in the works. Frank Millard is hoping to pour concrete for the Courthouse front steps this week. Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported he attended a Zoning Commission meeting last week and will have a Board of Adjustment meeting next Monday. He has items on the agenda. CDS Director Ken Hyndman reported he will attend a SEIL meeting tomorrow. County Auditor Terri Johnson reported her office is busy preparing for the primary election. In-Person absentee voting will begin in the Auditor's Office on May 18th and end June 6th. If a voter sent in an absentee ballot request form to have a ballot mailed, the ballot will be mailed on May 18th. On Saturday June 4th the Auditor's Office will be open for absentee voting from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. She reminded everyone to make sure to bring their photo ID when voting absentee at the Auditor's Office or voting at their polling location on election day. County Engineer Brian Carter stated projects are moving along. They hope to have Pleasant Grove Road open in 2-3 weeks, depending on weather. The Geode Road project is getting close to completion with one or two concrete pours left. The contractors hope to have Mediapolis Road open this week. Carter reported there was a bad accident on Highway 61 today. He wants to remind everyone to please put your phones down and pay attention to the road, especially with all the road construction and trucks turning in the area. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist reported her office mailed out delinquent tax notices and tax sale notices last week. Friday is the last day to make a payment before the delinquent list is published in the newspaper. Veterans Affairs Administrator Brooke Marland stated she remains busy. Public Health Administrator Christa Poggemiller reported her office is busy and she has an item on the agenda.

No correspondence was received.

Iowa DNR 28E Agreement was presented. This is an intergovernmental agreement between the Iowa DNR, Des Moines County Supervisors and the Des Moines County Board of Health to issue and ensure compliance with private water well construction permits. McCampbell made a motion to approve and seconded by Broeker.

Resolution #2022-035 and Final Plat for Oetken Subdivision was presented by Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter. This is a three-lot subdivision containing 165.51 acres in part of Section 29 and 30 in Jackson Twp. Subdivider: Jim Oetken, 18064 170<sup>th</sup> Ave. Yarmouth, IA 52660. Lassiter recommended approval. McCampbell made a motion to approve and seconded by Broeker.
