The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, December 20th, 2022, with Chairman Jim Cary, and Member Tom Broeker present. Vice-Chair Shane McCampbell was present via Webex. This meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Judge Joshua Schier administered the oath of office to re-elected County Attorney Lisa Schaefer, Supervisor Tom Broeker, and County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist.

Meet with Department Heads: Deputy Auditor Sara Doty reported the office is busy. Director Colin Gerst reported his office remains busy. Sheriff Kevin Glendening reported the jail population is 81. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported the office remains busy. County Attorney Lisa Schaefer stated she is working on the budget. There was a jury trial held last week. Conservation Director Chris Lee reported there are still a couple spots open for the youth winter camp that starts next week. You can sign up on the Conservation website. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist reported they wrapped up the application process and she is hoping to start interviews soon. SEIL CDS Director Ken Hyndman gave a SEIL update. County Auditor Terri Johnson reported this is her last official meeting before retirement. County Engineer Brian Carter stated his crew is preparing for the upcoming snow we are supposed to receive. The bridge crew on Highway 99 is still moving along. He is working on his department budget. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener reported his crew is busy preparing for the snow. County Recorder Natalie Steffener reported her office is busy. Public Health Director Christa Poggemiller stated her office is still offering covid and flu vaccines on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Her staff continues to do mosquito trapping and reviewing the results they have received from Iowa State.
