#### Memorandum of Understanding

- 2. **Out Clause**: Any party may terminate this Agreement at any time with written notice to the other parties.







KEVIN GLENDENING, SHERIFF

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in a regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025, with Chair Jim Cary, Vice-Chair Shane McCampbell and Member Tom Broeker present. This meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Meeting with Department Heads: County Auditor Sara Doty thanked the public for the contribution to the food drive her office held last month. Her office remains busy working on end of fiscal year items. Sheriff Kevin Glendening reported the jail population is at 78. Public Health Director Christa Poggemiller reported her office is busy. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported he has an agenda item. Conservation Director Chris Lee stated they will hold the Outdoor Youth Jamboree at Big Hollow this weekend. They also have River Days at the Riverfront the following weekend and summer camps beginning for the youth at Starrs Cave. Safety Director Angela Vaughan reported she is busy. Administrative Assistant Becky Purchase reported the Contractor at the Highway 99 project is starting at 7 ponds road today with the milling process and hoping to wrap that portion up this week.

No correspondence was received.

Approval of Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$699,328.15 were presented. McCampbell made a motion to approve and was seconded by Broeker.

Broeker started the meeting off by thanking the members of the County for their concerns, their input, their thoughts, and the willingness to work with each other in a kind respective manner.
