The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in a regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026, with Chair Shane McCampbell, Vice Chair Tom Broeker, and Member Jim Cary present. The meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Item 4B was removed from the agenda.

Meeting with Department Heads: IT Director Brandon Mehmert reported his office is busy. Conservation Director Chris Lee stated his crew is keeping busy. Chief Deputy Brad Siegfried stated the jail numbers are running high this morning. Things are the Sheriff's Department are keeping busy. County Auditor Sara Doty reported she is keeping busy with budget. Local Health Director Christa Poggemiller reported her office is busy. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter stated he has a couple minor subdivisions on the agenda. His office remains busy. Veterans Affairs Director Brooke Marland stated Coffee and Conversation at Wake N Bake will be held tomorrow morning at 9:00 a.m. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener stated the Sheriff's parking lot project is out for bid until tomorrow at 1:30 p.m. He continues to work on his budget. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist stated her office is training on a new IDOT system that will be coming out in early 2027. County Engineer Brian Carter stated his crews are out spot blading. He is currently working on his budget as well.


