The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in a regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, July 21st, 2026, Vice Chair Tom Broeker present. Chair Shane McCampbell joined the meeting via phone. The meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. Item4A was removed from the agenda.

Meeting with Department Heads: Assistant County Attorney Trent Henkelvig reported a jury trial is taking place upstairs for what could be the next 8 days. Their office is keeping busy. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported he is moving agenda item 4A to next week due to an adjustment on the plat. His office is keeping busy. IT Director Brandon Mehmert reported his office is busy. Chief Deputy Brad Siegfried stated the jail currently has 22 inmates out of county, 5 were transported to Oakdale, with a total of 96 this morning. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener stated the state elevator inspector was here last week and everything went well. Local Health Director Christa Poggemiller reminds the public of their immunization clinics for the upcoming school year. She attended a Board of Health meeting last week, along with Member Jim Cary. She would also like to thank Linda Long's Estate for the generous donation to 2x4 for Veterans and Ringo Covert for all his hard work in this project. Emergency Management Director Shannon Prado stated that she is working through grants for the upcoming year. She went on a tour of the bitcoin mining facility along with County Auditor Sara Doty and the Burlington Fire Department. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist reported her office is gearing up to receive the new 2025 property tax file from the Auditor's Office. Veterans Affairs Director Brooke Marland would like to echo Christa in thanking Linda Long's Estate for the generous donation, and Ringo Covert for his hard work to the 2x4 for Veterans. County Engineer Brian Carter reported the City of Burlington is going to change the intersection of South Gear and West Avenue to a 4-way stop. His crew is out patching concrete and have had quite a few concrete blow ups with the heat recently. He would like to thank his crew for their hard work. County Auditor Sara Doty reported she is hiring for a Real Estate Administrative Assistant. Applications are being accepted in the Auditor's Office through close of business on August 11th. RESOLUTION #2026-048

WHEREAS Des Moines County requires an application and permit for fireworks display,

WHEREAS J&M Displays Inc., a fireworks display company headquarters in Yarmouth Iowa has approached the County seeking an annual authorization to display fireworks in the unincorporated areas of the county so long as the conditions allow;

WHEREAS J&M Displays Inc., has a long history of using fireworks shooters who have successfully completed an American Pyrotechnics Association (APA) fireworks training program for display operators,

WHEREAS J&M Displays Inc., has a long history of safely conducting fireworks displays in Des Moines County.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DES MOINES COUNTY that J&M Display Inc. is authorized to conduct a fireworks displays within the unincorporated areas of Des Moines County without specific approval so long as an application for permit has been properly submitted for 48 hours prior to the display and no objection has been heard by an area Fire Chief or a Des Moines County Supervisors. For the current fiscal year starting July 1, 2026, and ending on June 31, 2027.

Future Agenda Items – Discussion regarding the sale of the three real estate lots at 1804 Douglas Ave.

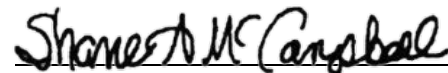
During public input, Brian Carter noted that the Des Moines County Fair begins next week.
