

August 18, 2026

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in a regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, August 18th, 2026, with Chair Shane McCampbell, Vice-Chair Tom Broeker, and member Jim Cary present. The meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously.

Meeting with Department Heads: County Auditor Sara Doty stated she will be heading to the ISAC Conference this week in Des Moines along with some of the other Department Heads. Her office is busy. Emergency Management Director Shannon Prado reported there is more rain coming this week so be prepared. The Salvation Army has flood kits available at no cost to the public for anyone who has a flooded basement from the recent weather. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener reported his office is trying to get the grass mowed in between the rain. Conservation Director Chris Lee stated August 21st they are holding a smores night at Big Hollow, the Full Moon Paddle will be on August 28th, and Sept 5th All About Monarchs will take place. September 9th will be an installment of Leadership on the Landscape. His crew will be working on the end of Flint River Trail that has been overgrown. County Assessor Matt Warner reported his office is working on 2027 assessments and working towards incorporating all the legislative changes. Public Health Director Christa Poggemiller stated there has been confirmed cases of measles in southern Iowa. If you have symptoms, make sure to reach out to your Health Care Provider for an exam. She stated she is waiting for the RFP to open regarding the Public Health redistricting. There is discussion of Public Health moving into 7 districts and the goal is to have that begin January of 2027. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist stated the 2025 tax statements were mailed last Friday. Her office remains busy. IT Director Brandon Mehmert reported his office is busy. County Sheriff Kevin Glendening stated his office is assisting the Fire Department with radio programming. They have recently done safety training with Danville Community School District. There is a murder trial taking place in Keokuk this week. He attended an E911 meeting last night to discuss the Descom Director position they recently interviewed for. Kirk Schneden was awarded the position. The jail population is 91. Veterans Affairs Director Brooke Marland reported they had Coffee & Conversation last week with 20 present. County Recorder Natalie Steffener stated fees for hunting and fishing licenses are going to increase by \$5 as of December 15th. The deer and turkey licenses won't increase until 2027. This money will go to the Fish & Wildlife Trust Fund. Assistant County Attorney Trent Henkelvig reported the murder trial has started back up in Keokuk this week. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported his office is busy. County Engineer Brian Carter stated with all of the rain we have had, his crew is out blading roads and taking care of erosion spots. His crew is pouring concrete on Pleasant Grove Road this morning, in a spot where there was a heat blow up. The Pleasant Grove Road project has slowed down some with the rain, but they are hoping to close Iowa City/Pleasant Grove intersection to pour concrete the week of August 31st.

Approval of Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$468,692.79 was presented. Cary made a motion to approve and was seconded by Broeker.

Approval of Payroll Reimbursement Claims in the amount of \$3,107.01 were presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

Approval of a Class C Liquor License for Spirit Hollow Clubhouse was presented. County Sheriff Kevin Glendening reported no issues with this. Broeker made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

Approval of a Fireworks Permit for Myers Tree Farm on August 15th, 2026, was presented. County Sheriff Kevin Glendening reported no issues with this. Cary made a motion to approve and was seconded by Broeker.

Approval of a Fireworks Permit for Clover Creek Event Venue for August 29th, 2026, was presented. County Sheriff Kevin Glendening reported no issue with this. County Engineer Brian Carter questioned who notifies the City when a permit is approved within City limits. County Auditor Sara Doty reported that she reaches out to the City when a permit has been approved by the Board. Firework permits are handled differently than alcohol licenses when it comes to districting. Broeker made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

Approval of Personnel Actions were presented: Public Health, Holly Barksdale, Home Health Coordinator,

Retirement effective 10/30/26. Cary made a motion to approve and was seconded by Broeker. Treasurer – Jillian Allen, Clerk II, MV Department, 42-month step increase, \$43,701.87 yearly effective 8/13/26. Broeker made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

Cary made a motion to approve August 11th, 2026, regular meeting minutes and was seconded by Broeker. Broeker then stated that he abstained.

Broeker attended a Descom Control Board meeting and Cary attended a RUSS meeting.

During public input, Tom questioned SEIRPC if they would like to have a work session to discuss the SEIRPC working on the Data Center Ordinance. Auditor Doty stated that she has spoke with Zach and they plan to have a work session next week regarding this. Tom then read information on data centers that he had researched recently to the public.

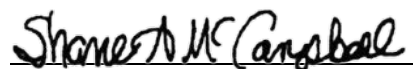
