

September 15, 2026

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in a regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, September 15th, 2026, with Chair Shane McCampbell, Vice-Chair Tom Broeker, and member Jim Cary present. The meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously.

Meeting with Department Heads: Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener reported his crew is busy. Sheriff Kevin Glendening stated he has a District 7 Mental Health Advisory Council meeting he will be attending tomorrow. Statewide jail school is also taking place this week. The jail population is 100. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported his office is keeping busy. He has nothing for the agenda today but likely a minor subdivision for next week and a small stream of subdivisions that are being processed in the office currently. County Auditor Sara Doty reported that as of this morning she has received 431 Absentee Ballot Request Forms for the 2026 General Election. She continues to stay busy preparing for the upcoming election. Safety Director Angela Vaughan reported she is busy. Assistant County Attorney Trent Henkelvig stated their office remains busy. IT Director Brandon Mehmert stated his office is busy. County Engineer Brian Carter stated the Pleasant Grove Project is moving along. The contractors were hoping to get concrete poured this week, but due to the weather they may have to move it out for a few days. He added a project tour to the agenda, but due to the weather, he stated it might be better to do next week after the concrete pour.

Approval of Payroll Reimbursement Claims in the amount of \$0 were presented. Cary made a motion to approve and was seconded by Broeker.

Approval of Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$485,990.19 were presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

Approval of County Owned Recycling Trailer Use Request of Burlington Renewable Energy and Conservation Committee was presented. City Manager Chad Bird spoke to the Board regarding this. The Board stated they are ok with moving forward to adding the MOU and Resolution to the agenda for approval next week.

Approval of Request for Appointment of Jennifer Lehman to Southeast Iowa Regional Housing Authority was presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

Approval of a Class C Liquor License for 14133 Irish Ridge Rd. for October 1, 2026, was presented. Cary made a motion to approve and was seconded by Broeker.

Approval of Request for Delay of Property Taxes was presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and was seconded by Cary.

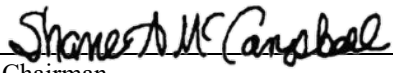
The meeting was adjourned at 9:25 a.m.
